



SEABISCUIT RANCH®

2005 TRIFECTA (Bordeaux Blend), Mendocino County appellation:

This is an exceptional red wine blend of three classic varieties. It is our third vintage release of Seabiscuit Ranch TRIFECTA. Our objective is to produce a proprietary true “reserve” quality wine comprised primarily of Cabernet Sauvignon with nuances gained with the addition of Merlot and Cabernet Franc. All these varieties develop mouth-filling fruit flavors and finesse in Mendocino County.

Winemaker’s Comments:

“The 2005 weather was relatively constant – without extremes – slightly cooler than normal and dry. This allowed the grapes to mature slowly and develop flavors of ripe plums, cherries and blackberries. The grapes were harvested by hand, crushed into stainless steel tanks and fermented dry. In November 2005 after pressing, the wines were transferred into small American oak barrels for flavors to develop and natural tannins to soften.

After 15 months in barrels, in February 2007 we selected the premium barrels of each variety and made the blend that went into new small Central European oak barrels for six additional months of aging prior to final blending and bottling. The wine has deep purple color, concentrated ripe fruit aromas and flavors, with medium-to-robust body. It has soft tannins and is ideal for drinking now, yet will benefit from further bottle aging for many years.”

The grape blend follows. Cabernet Sauvignon: 80%; Merlot: 14%; Cabernet Franc: 6%.

In winemaking, we selected our *trifecta* of three reserve quality classic varietals, blending to create the *winning combination* of a proprietary *exceptional wine*. Enjoy!”
